

KYABRAM WESTERN GUMS TOURIST PARK RULES

- All fees are to be paid in full on arrival and before proceeding into the park.
- A limit of one vehicle with caravan or trailer per powered site is permitted within the park.
- Cars to be driven at WALKING PACE ONLY.
- All enquiries are to be made to the **Kyabram Western Gums Tourist Park Number (03) 5852 2885.** Office hours are 8.30am - 6.00pm (these may vary on weekends).
- Check- in time is 2pm, however if a site and facilities are available beforehand every attempt will be made to facilitate an earlier check-in. Check out time is 10.00am on day of departure. You are requested to please ensure your site is left neat and tidy on your departure.
- All visitors entering the park must notify management before proceeding and must leave the Park by 10.00pm.
- No visitors' cars permitted within the park except in the visitors parking area provided unless agreement has been made with Park management. You are responsible for your visitor's behaviour.
- Double adaptors from power boxes will NOT be allowed.
- Pets are allowed on sites at management's discretion and must be kept on a leash/restrained at all times. Pet owners must dispose of droppings. Pets must not be left unattended and are not permitted in the pool area. Please check when booking. Pets are not permitted into the camp kitchen area.
- Noise must be kept at acceptable levels at all times with no undue noise after 10.00pm.
- Ball games and children's activities are to be conducted only in the areas provided for such activities.
- No smoking permitted in the designated enclosed communal areas and in and around areas, where food is prepared, cooked and/or consumed.
- FIRES ARE STRICTLY ONLY PERMITTED IN COMMUNAL FIRE PIT LOCATED AT CAMP KITCHEN.
- No trenches or other earth works are to be dug or built.
- All rubbish is to be placed in bins provided (preferably in plastic bags unless for recycle).
- Power for a site must only be obtained from a single power point.
- Children must be properly supervised at all times.
- Children under five years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times within the park.
- Bicycles must be ridden in a sensible manner and only on roadways, and only during daylight hours. Parents are responsible for ensuring children wear protective headgear when riding. Bicycles are not to be left in public walkways or in a manner to cause nuisance or danger. Parent, and/or accompanying adult, is responsible for the action of any resulting incident arising from bicycle riding. No liability is accepted in any form by the Park owners or management.
- Chemical toilets must only be emptied into the dump point provided on the northern end of the amenities block.
- Refunds Occupying a site for fewer days than originally booked no refund.
- Children under 10 need to be supervised at all times in the swimming pool, failure to adhere to pool rules will result in being asked to leave the pool area and be banned from use of the facility.
- Swimming pool rules are posted at the entrance to the pool.

Emergency Procedure

In the event of a small local fire there are extinguishers and fire hydrants located at various points around the park. Locations are shown on plans of the park displayed in the Laundry and Reception Area. If able, extinguish fire yourself or immediately advise Park Staff, or call Park Management on **(03) 5852 2885.**

Emergency Evacuation

Staff will advise you if a situation arises requiring evacuation of the park. If asked to leave, secure your accommodation and immediately proceed on foot to the designated assembly area shown on the rear of this notice. Do not attempt to move your car or caravan. Please remain in the assembly area until advised to leave by the Park staff.

Water Taps

- White taps are suitable for drinking water and appropriately labelled.
- Yellow Taps are unsuitable for drinking and are used for irrigation purposes.
